Nobody flees without a reason! Solidarity with asylum seekers!

The parties - *CDU/CSU*, *SPD* and *die Grünen* – are planning a massive overhaul of the asylum law. On the 16th of October the new law will be decided on and on 1. November it will probably come into effect.

Consequences of the new law:

→ People, who defend themselves against their own deportation, will only receive the bare minimum of aid (bed and food)

→ In the refugee camps (LEA or BEA) asylum applicants will only receive donations (and will no longer receive money)

→ Those refugees who resist deportation will be criminalized and placed in prison to await their deportation dates. The proposed new law also means that those individuals who aid refugees in their flight (into Germany) will face a minimum of 3 months in prison.

→ The new law particularly affects those refugees from the supposed 'safe countries', for example the Balkan countries. The list of the 'safe countries' will be extended to include Albania, Montenegro and Kosovo. Refugees from these countries will not be allowed to leave the refugee camps (BEA or LEA) until their deportation date and will not be allowed to work.

These are all grave violations of human rights!

We won't accept it! Let's join together on the streets and demonstrate against deportation and this proposed law!

Nobody flees without a reason! Solidarity with asylum seekers!

Against the segregation and accommodation in camps – we stand for living together with refugees and for more social housing!

Against the stigmatization and exclusion of Roma and all other refugees!

We are determined to prevent deportation through acts of civil disobedience and peaceful demonstrations!
